### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Lexington to refund a Sum of Money to E. S. Wetherbee.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Lexington may refund to  
2 E. S. Wetherbee such sum of money on account of taxes  
3 overpaid by said Wetherbee to said town as the voters  
4 of said town shall, by vote at a legal town meeting,  
5 determine.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
