### AN ACT

To extend the Term of Office of the Board of Commissioners for the promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The term of office of the board of com-  
2 missioners for the promotion of uniformity of legislation  
3 in the United States, created by chapter four hundred  
4 and five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
5 ninety-one, as amended by chapter three hundred and  
6 eleven of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
7 ninety-three, is hereby extended for the term of five  
8 years from the passage of this act.

1 SECT. 2. The sum of nine hundred and thirty-two  
2 dollars and eighty-two cents, being the unexpended bal-  
3 ance of the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars originally  
4 appropriated to carry out the provisions of said act, may  
5 be expended for such necessary expenses as may be in-  
6 curred by said board of commissioners in the perform-  
7 ance of their duties.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
