AN ACT

Relative to the Incurring of Permanent Indebtedness in
Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In every case where action is to be taken
2 by a town in town meeting, relative to the incurring of
3 indebtedness to an amount beyond what is to be paid for
4 by the tax levy of the current year, an article shall be
5 inserted in the warrant for such meeting, stating that
6 such action will be taken, and the vote on the question
7 of incurring such indebtedness shall be taken by ballot in
8 the same manner as the vote on the question of granting
9 licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
2 with are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
