### AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the Blue Hill Evangelical Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Blue Hill Evangelical Society may  
2 take and hold real and personal estate for the purpose of  
3 establishing and maintaining a free public reading room  
4 and library and for other benevolent, philanthropic or  
5 educational purposes.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
