RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Improvements at the Asylum for
Insane Criminals at the State Farm at Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 eighteen thousand three hundred dollars to be expended
4 under the direction of the trustees and superintendent
5 for the following purposes: for the erection of a strong
6 isolation ward for dangerous and incorrigible cases to
7 contain not less than fifteen rooms, including heating,
8 furnishing and plumbing, a sum not exceeding twelve
9 thousand dollars; for brick and concrete paving and
10 additional fencing, a sum not exceeding two thousand
11 dollars; for renovating northwest wing for acute cases
12 and providing storage rooms and central bathing station
13 for modern rain-bath, a sum not exceeding four thou-
14 sand three hundred dollars.
