AN ACT

Relative to the Construction of the Approaches to the New
Charlestown Bridge in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer of the city of Boston shall
2 from time to time on the request of the mayor of said
3 city, issue and sell negotiable bonds or certificates of
4 said city to an amount not exceeding the sum required
5 for carrying out any order of the board of street commis-
6 sioners of said city laying out, locating anew, altering,
7 widening and requiring the construction of Charlestown
8 street, from Haymarket square to Causeway street in
9 said city, as one of the approaches to the new bridge
10 now being constructed by the Boston transit commission
11 between Boston and Charlestown. Said bonds or certifi-
12 cates shall be issued as a part of, and in addition to, and
13 in the same manner as, the bonds or certificates issued
14 under authority of chapter three hundred and twenty-
15 three of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
16 ninety-one, and acts in amendment or addition thereto,
17 and the provisions of said acts, so far as applicable, shall
18 apply to the carrying out of the provisions of this act.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
