AN ACT

Providing Relief for the Société St. Jean Baptiste de West
Boylston, Mass.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Société St. Jean Baptiste de West
2 Boylston, Mass., a corporation duly established, located
3 at West Boylston, shall be entitled to the sum of twenty-
4 one thousand, nine hundred seventeen dollars and forty
5 cents, as damages caused to the members of said corpo-
6 ration in consequence of the construction of the metro-
7 politan water basin at West Boylston aforesaid, the said
8 amount to be paid in accordance with the provisions of
9 chapter four hundred eighty-eight of the acts of the year
10 eighteen hundred and ninety-five.

1 SECT. 2. Said sum shall be paid to the members of
2 said corporation who were in good standing on the books
3 thereof on the first day of January eighteen hundred and
4 ninety-seven, in proportion to the amounts said members
5 have severally contributed to the funds of said corpora-
6 tion.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
