### AN ACT

To provide a Seal for Town and City Clerks and City Registrars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Every town clerk and city clerk and registrar may  
2 have an official seal of a design to be approved by the  
3 selectmen of the town, or the mayor of the city of which  
4 he is clerk or registrar, which seal may be used in  
5 authenticating all papers and copies of papers or records  
6 issued or furnished by such clerk or registrar in his  
7 official capacity.
