In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-seven.

RESOLVE

In favor of the Town of Nantucket.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the town of Nantucket
3 the sum of forty-four dollars and ten cents, being the
4 amount expended in caring for four seamen who were
5 wrecked on Nantucket bar on the twentieth day of April
6 in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, said sea-
7 men having no settlement in this Commonwealth.
