Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To extend the Time in which the Town of Uxbridge may accept the Act authorizing said Town to increase its Water Supply.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eleven of chapter two hundred and five of the
2 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "three" in the fourth
4 line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word
5 "five," so that said section as amended shall read as
6 follows:—

7 *Section 11.* This act shall take effect upon its accept-
8 ance by two-thirds vote of the voters of the town of
9 Uxbridge present and voting thereon at a legal town
10 meeting called for the purpose within five years from its
11 passage; but the number of meetings so called in any
12 year shall not exceed three.
