AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses
of the Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 eight, to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the gas and electric light
9 commissioners, eight thousand dollars. [Acts
10 1885, chap. 314.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$8,000.)

11 For clerical assistance of the gas and electric
12 light commissioners, a sum not exceeding three
13 thousand dollars. [Acts 1895, chap. 463.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$3,000.)

14 For statistics, books and stationery, and for the
15 necessary expenses of the gas and electric light
16 commissioners, a sum not exceeding three thou-
17 sand dollars. [Acts 1895, chap. 463.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$3,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
