AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts
School for the Feeble-minded.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of twenty-five thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the
4 ordinary revenue, to the Massachusetts School for
5 the Feeble-minded, as provided for by chapter
6 one hundred and twenty-three of the acts of the
7 year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

(Appropriation 1897, \$25,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
