AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for operating the Charles River Valley System of Sewerage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding sixty-two
2 thousand five hundred dollars is hereby appro-
3 priated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for
5 the purpose of providing for the cost of the
6 maintenance and operation of the system of
7 sewage disposal for the cities of Boston, New-
8 ton and Waltham, and the towns of Watertown
9 and Brookline, known as the Charles river valley
10 system, during the year ending on the thirty-
11 first day of December, in the year eighteen hun-
12 dred and ninety-eight. [Acts 1889, chap. 439,
13 sect. 13.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$31,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
