### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses of the District Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for  
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of De-  
6 cember, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
7 eight, to wit:—

8 For the salary of the chief of the district police,  
9 a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars.

(Appropriation 1897, \$2,500.)

11 For the salary of the first clerk in the office of  
12 the chief of the district police, fifteen hundred  
13 dollars. [Acts 1890, chap. 137.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$1,500.)

14 For the salary of the second clerk in the office  
15 of the chief of the district police, one thousand  
16 dollars. [Acts 1892, chap. 249.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$1,000.)

17 For the compensation of the forty-four mem-  
18 bers of the district police, a sum not exceeding  
19 sixty-five thousand dollars. [Pub. Stat., chap.  
20 103; Acts 1887, chaps. 127 and 256; 1888, chaps.  
21 389 and 426; 1891, chaps. 302 and 357; 1892,  
22 chap. 249; 1894, chap. 281; 1895, chaps. 396 and  
23 418; 1896, chap. 546.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$65,000.)

24 For travelling expenses actually paid by mem-  
25 bers of the district police, a sum not exceeding  
26 twenty-one thousand three hundred dollars.

(Appropriation 1897, \$21,300.)

28 For incidental and contingent office expenses  
29 of the chief and members of the district police,  
30 a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars. [Pub.  
31 Stat., chap. 103.]

(Appropriation 1897, \$2,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
