[Bill accompanying the petition of J. B. L. BARTLETT. Election Laws.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To Reorganize the Board of Aldermen and Common Council
of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be elected by the registered
2 voters of each of the twenty-five wards of the city of
3 Boston at every annual municipal election under the same
4 provisions of law so far as applicable as those under
5 which members of the common council of said city are
6 now elected one alderman for the term of one year.

1 SECTION 2. There shall also be elected by the regis-
2 tered voters of each of the twenty-five wards of said city
3 at every annual municipal election under the same pro-
4 visions of law as those under which members of the

5 common council of said city are now elected two mem-
6 bers of the common council.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts providing for
2 the election of aldermen and members of the common
3 council of said city or inconsistent with this act are
4 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
