AN ACT

To extend the Provisions of the Public Statutes Relating to the Taxable Valuation of Vessels Engaged in the Foreign Carrying Trade.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of section ten of chapter
2 eleven of the Public Statutes as amended or renewed by
3 chapter three hundred and seventy-three of the acts of
4 the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, chapter two
5 hundred and eighty-six of the acts of the year eighteen
6 hundred and eighty-nine, chapter one hundred and six-
7 teen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
8 one, and chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the acts
9 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three are hereby
10 renewed and extended for the term of five years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
