In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Fall River to incur Indebtedness beyond the Limit fixed by Law, for Sewerage Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fall River, for the purpose
2 of extending the sewer outlets at the foot of Cove street,
3 Odd street and Ferry street into Taunton river at said
4 city, may incur indebtedness beyond its debt limit to an
5 amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and
6 may issue bonds, notes or scrip therefor. Said bonds,
7 notes or scrip shall be payable within such period, not
8 exceeding thirty years from the date thereof, and shall
9 bear such rate of interest, as the city council shall deter-
10 mine. Any sum which may remain after the construc-
11 tion of the outlets as herein provided, may be used for

12 the extension of the sewerage system of said city. Ex-
13 cept as herein otherwise provided, the provisions of
14 chapter twenty-nine of the Public Statutes, and of acts
15 in amendment thereof, and in addition thereto shall, so
16 far as applicable, apply to the indebtedness hereby au-
17 thorized, and to the securities issued therefor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
