
[Bill accompanying the petition of Haverhill, Georgetown and Danvers Street Railway Company. Street Railways.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the Haverhill, Georgetown and Danvers Street Railway Company to Construct and Operate its Railway in the Towns of Newbury, Rowley and Ipswich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Haverhill, Georgetown and Danvers
2 Street Railway Company is hereby authorized to con-
3 struct, maintain and operate its railway in the towns of
4 Newbury, Rowley and Ipswich upon locations that may
5 be granted by the selectmen of said towns respectively
6 and subject to such limitations and conditions as may be
7 imposed by said selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. Said company may construct, maintain
2 and operate its railway on private lands with the consent
3 of the owners thereof, and it may lease, purchase and
4 hold lands for said purpose.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage, and shall be void as to all parts of said railway
3 which are not located and constructed in said towns
4 within two years from the passage of this act.
