AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Patent and Proprietary

Medicines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Whoever sells any patent or pro-
- 2 prietary medicines, except upon the written pre-
- 3 scription of a physician, shall affix to the bottle,
- 4 box or wrapper containing the article sold a label
- 5 upon which shall be printed in clear type and in
- 6 plain view of the purchaser the name and per
- 7 centum of each ingredient contained in such
- 8 medicine.
- 9 Whoever neglects to affix such label shall be 10 punished by fine not exceeding fifty dollars for 11 each offence.
