### AN ACT

To define the Limits of Buzzard's Bay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In the statutes of this Commonwealth  
2 the term "waters of Buzzards bay" shall be deemed to  
3 mean the body of water commonly known as Buzzard's  
4 bay and extending southwesterly to a line drawn from  
5 Cuttyhunk lighthouse to the southerly extremity of  
6 Gooseberry neck in the town of Westport.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
