### AN ACT

Relative to Public Baths and Gymnasia in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of bath commissioners of the  
2 city of Boston shall have the control, care and mainte-  
3 nance of all public baths and indoor gymnasia heretofore  
4 or hereafter established by said city, including those in  
5 or on public parks, and including also all floating bath-  
6 houses, and may hereafter erect and maintain any public  
7 baths, floating bath-houses or indoor gymnasia for which  
8 the city council may appropriate money. Chapter two  
9 hundred and sixty-six of the acts of eighteen hundred  
10 and eighty-five, and all acts relating to the city of Bos-  
11 ton and the officers and employees thereof, shall, so far  
12 as applicable, apply to the bath department of said city  
13 and the officers and employees thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
