AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment of Constables in Cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In every city which adopts the provisions
2 of this act in the manner herein provided constables shall
3 be appointed by the mayor and aldermen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in any city in
2 which it is accepted by vote of the city council thereof
3 or such board as has the powers of a city council.
