## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Medford to make an Additional Public Building Loan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Medford, for the pur-  
2 pose of erecting school houses and engine houses,  
3 may incur indebtedness to an amount not exceed-  
4 ing one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars,  
5 in addition to the amount heretofore authorized by  
6 law to be incurred by said city for building pur-  
7 poses; and may, from time to time, by a vote  
8 passed in the manner provided by section seven  
9 of chapter twenty-nine of the Public Statutes,  
10 issue and sell bonds or scrip therefor. Said  
11 bonds or scrip shall be designated on the face  
12 thereof "Medford Public Building Loan, Act  
13 of 1898," shall be signed by the mayor and  
14 treasurer and countersigned by the auditor of  
15 said city, shall be payable in periods not exceed-

16 ing twenty years from the date of issue and shall  
17 bear interest at a rate not exceeding four per  
18 cent. per annum, payable semi-annually: *provided*,  
19 that the whole amount of such bonds or scrip  
20 issued by said city, together with those heretofore  
21 authorized to be issued by said city for the same  
22 purposes, shall not, in any event, exceed the  
23 amount of three hundred and seventy-five thou-  
24 sand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section two of  
2 chapter one hundred and sixty-seven of the acts  
3 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three  
4 shall apply to the indebtedness authorized by this  
5 act, and to bonds or scrip issued under the  
6 authority hereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
