RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Middlesex.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appro-
 2 priated for the expenses of the county of Middlesex for
 3 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.
- \$40,500 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding forty
 5 thousand five hundred dollars.
- 46,000 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
 7 forty-six thousand dollars.
- 34,000 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants fixed by
 9 law, a sum not exceeding thirty-four thousand dollars.
- 67,000 10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not ex-
 11 ceeding sixty-seven thousand dollars.
- 70,000 12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts,
 13 a sum not exceeding seventy thousand dollars.
- 110,000 14 For salaries of jailors, masters and assistants, and sup-
 15 port of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum
 16 not exceeding one hundred and ten thousand dollars.
- 35,000 17 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not ex-
 18 ceeding thirty-six thousand dollars.
- 50,000 19 For civil expenses in the supreme and superior courts,
 20 a sum not exceeding fifty thousand dollars.
- 3,200 21 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding three thousand
 22 two hundred dollars.

23	For transportation expenses of county and special	\$600
24	commissioners, a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.	
25	For medical examiners, inquests and commitments of	12,000
26	the insane, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars.	
27	For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceed-	7,000

29	For repairing, furnishing and improving county build-	30,000
30	ings, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand dollars.	
31	For care, fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings,	30,000
32	other than jails and houses of correction, a sum not ex-	
33	ceeding thirty thousand dollars.	
34	For highways, including state highways, bridges and	32,500
35	land damages, a sum not exceeding thirty-two thousand	
36	five hundred dollars.	
37	For law libraries, a sum not exceeding two thousand	2,000
38	dollars.	
39	For truant schools, a sum not exceeding sixteen thou-	16,000
40	sand dollars.	
41	For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the cur-	5,000
42	rent year, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.	
43	And the county commissioners of said county are	448,000
44	hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said	
45	county for the current year, in the manner provided by	
46	law, the sum of four hundred and forty-eight thousand	
47	dollars, to be expended together with the cash balance	
48	on hand and the receipts from the other sources for the	
49	above purposes.
