AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Lincoln to release Certain
Lands and Easements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Lincoln, for the pur-
2 pose of compromising the claims of George G.
3 Tarbell and Helen V. V. Warren on account of
4 damages occasioned to their respective estates by
5 reason of certain alleged takings of land made by
6 the water commissioners of Lincoln, on the tenth
7 day of March, in the year eighteen hundred and
8 ninety-six, is hereby authorized to release to the
9 said Tarbell and Warren respectively such lands
10 and such rights and easements therein as the said
11 town may deem proper, and the selectmen are
12 authorized in the name of the town to execute
13 and deliver to the said owners such releases in
14 conformity with this act as the town has directed
15 or may hereafter direct by vote.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
