### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Newburyport to Incur Indebtedness  
beyond its Debt Limit for School Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Newburyport, for the pur-  
2 pose of providing additional school accommodations in  
3 said city, may incur indebtedness beyond its debt  
4 limit to an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand  
5 dollars. The provisions of chapter twenty-nine of the  
6 Public Statutes, and of chapter one hundred and twenty-  
7 nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-  
8 four, and of acts in amendment thereof and in addition  
9 thereto, shall, except as herein otherwise provided,  
10 apply to the indebtedness hereby authorized and the  
11 securities issued therefor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
