RESOLVE

To provide for Repairs and Additions to the United States Ship "Minnesota."

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 twenty-five hundred dollars, to be expended by the ad-
4 jutant-general of the Commonwealth, for the purpose of
5 making certain repairs on and additions to the United
6 States ship "Minnesota," at present loaned by the United
7 States to the Commonwealth for the use of the naval
8 militia.
