AN ACT

Relative to the Boundary Line between the Towns of Gay
Head and Chilmark.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the
2 provisions of section two of chapter three hundred and
3 twenty-three of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
4 and ninety-seven, for marking the boundary line between
5 the towns of Gay Head and Chilmark by building a suit-
6 able protection to the banks on each side of the new
7 outlet from Menamsha pond to Vineyard Sound, the
8 board of harbor and land commissioners is hereby auth-
9 orized to expend a sum not exceeding two thousand
10 dollars in addition to the amount authorized by said
11 section two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
