AN ACT

Relative to the Board of Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter three hundred
2 and fourteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-five is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 "three" in the second line thereof and inserting in place
5 thereof the word "four" and by striking out the word
6 "two" in the third line thereof and inserting in place
7 thereof the word "three" and by inserting after the
8 word "Commonwealth" in the fourth line thereof the
9 following: "The members and clerk of said board shall
10 not engage in any other business," so that said section as
11 amended shall read as follows:—

12 *Section 4.* The annual salary of the chairman of the
13 board shall be four thousand dollars and that of the other
14 commissioners three thousand five hundred dollars each
15 to be paid monthly from the treasury of the Common-
16 wealth. The members and clerk of said board shall not

17 engage in any other business. The commissioners shall
18 be provided with an office in the State house or in some
19 other public place in the city of Boston, in which their
20 record shall be kept.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter five hundred and three of the acts
2 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four is hereby
3 repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
