RESOLVE

To provide for certain Improvements at the Medfield Insane Asylum.

- 1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
- 2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
- 3 fifteen thousand dollars to be expended at the Medfield
- 4 Insane Asylum, under the direction of the trustees thereof,
- 5 for a new building for the administration of the mechan-
- 6 ical departments of the institution, or for an addition to
- 7 the present engine room.
