Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Marblehead to appropriate Money for the Assistance of Citizens of said town enlisting for Service in the Cuban War.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Marblehead may, by a
2 majority vote of the voters thereof in a town meeting
3 called for the purpose, appropriate money to assist per-
4 sons entering the military or naval service of the United
5 States for service in the present war with Spain.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
