Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the West End Street Railway Company to replace its Tracks on Tremont and Boylston streets in the city of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The West End Street Railway Com-
2 pany is hereby authorized to replace its surface
3 tracks upon that portion of Tremont street between
4 Boylston street and Scollay square, and upon that
5 portion of Boylston street between Park square
6 and Tremont street, which tracks were removed
7 in accordance with the order of the Boston tran-
8 sit commission, under the provisions of section

9 thirty-five of chapter five hundred and forty-eight
10 of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-four.
11 Said tracks shall be replaced upon the locations
12 existing at the date of said order of removal ; and
13 said West End Street Railway Company shall
14 have the right to operate and maintain its cars
15 thereon in the same manner as if said order of
16 removal had not been made.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
