AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Current Expenses at
the Massachusetts Hospital for Epileptics.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding twenty
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be
3 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth,
4 from the ordinary revenue, for the purpose of
5 meeting current expenses at the Massachusetts
6 hospital for epileptics at Monson during the
7 year ending on the thirty-first day of December
8 in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

(Appropriation 1898, \$25,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
