AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for continuing the Work
of exterminating the Gypsy Moth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of two hundred thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the
4 ordinary revenue, to be expended under the
5 direction of the state board of agriculture, for
6 continuing the work of exterminating the oceria
7 dispar, or gypsy moth, during the year ending
8 the thirty-first day of December, in the year
9 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and the same

10 to be in addition to any amount unexpended of
11 the appropriation of the year eighteen hundred
12 and ninety-eight as authorized by chapter two
13 hundred and ten of the acts of the year eighteen
14 hundred and ninety-one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
