AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at the State Industrial School for Girls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine,
7 to wit: —

8 For the payment of salaries, wages and labor at
9 the State Industrial School for Girls, a sum not
10 exceeding fourteen thousand two hundred and
11 fifty dollars. [Pub. Stats., chap. 89.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$13,400.)

12 For current expenses at the State Industrial
13 School for Girls at Lancaster, a sum not exceed-

14 ing twenty thousand one hundred and twenty-five
15 dollars. [Pub. Stats., chap. 89.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$19,125.)

16 For expenses in connection with boarding out
17 younger girls from the State Industrial School, a
18 sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars.

19 [Acts 1895, chap. 429.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$2,500.)

20 For the education and instruction in the public
21 schools in any city or town in the Commonwealth
22 of children boarded or bound out by the trustees
23 of the Lyman and Industrial schools, a sum not
24 exceeding one hundred and twenty-five dollars.

2 passage.
