RESOLUTIONS

Relative to the Visit of the President of the United States
to the City of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court learns with pleas-
2 ure of the contemplated visit of William McKinley,
3 President of the United States, to the capitol city of this
4 Commonwealth; and that, as an expression of our high
5 regard for the office and for its distinguished incumbent,
6 we offer a cordial invitation to him to visit the General
7 Court on that occasion.

8 *Resolved*, That a joint special committee, to consist
9 of seven members on the part of the House and such as
10 the Senate may join, be appointed to extend to Presi-
11 dent McKinley the greetings of the General Court and
12 to tender this invitation.
