RESOLVE

In favor of the New England Industrial School for Deaf
Mutes.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth two thousand dollars to
3 the New England industrial school for deaf mutes, to be
4 expended under the direction of the trustees thereof for
5 the educational purposes of said school for the year
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine; and the said trustees
7 shall report to the state board of education.
