

HOUSE No. 233.

[Bill accompanying the petition of the Mayor of the City of Fitchburg,
Cities.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Fitchburg to Borrow Money
for the Erection of Hospital Buildings, and Gra-
ding of Grounds about the same.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg is hereby
2 authorized to borrow the sum of one hundred
3 thousand dollars and to issue its notes or certifi-
4 cates of indebtedness therefor at a rate of interest
5 not exceeding four per centum per annum, and
6 said money shall be expended for the erection of
7 hospital buildings, and grading the grounds about
8 the same, in said city as contemplated in the be-
9 quest made therefor in the will of Gardner S.

10 Burbank, late of said Fitchburg, deceased; *pro-*
11 *vided*, that from the sum received under said will
12 by said city, or by any person or corporation in
13 its behalf, no allowance shall be made for any in-
14 terest paid, or discount allowed, on account of
15 money borrowed and expended as aforesaid; *pro-*
16 *vided further*, that the indebtedness so created
17 by said city shall not be included in determining
18 the amount of debt said city is authorized to incur
19 under existing provisions of law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
