Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

RESOLVE

In favor of Thomas W. Mack.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Thomas W. Mack of
3 Boston, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in full
4 compensation for the loss occasioned to said Mack by
5 the injury of a horse owned by him and used by Frank
6 L. Locke, colonel and assistant inspector general on the
7 staff of his excellency, Roger Walcott, governor of said
8 Commonwealth and commander-in-chief of the Massa-
9 chusetts militia at the representation of said Common-
10 wealth at the Grant monument inaugural parade in the
11 city of New York on the twenty-seventh day of April,
12 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven. Said injury having
13 occurred while said horse was in the custody of said
14 Commonwealth, subsequent to said parade and prior to
15 its return to said Thomas W. Mack.
