### AN ACT

#### Requiring Railroad Companies to transport Bicycles as Baggage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Bicycles shall be deemed bag-  
2 gage, and shall be transported as baggage for  
3 passengers by railroad companies; and no such  
4 passenger shall be required to crate, cover or  
5 otherwise protect a bicycle so transported. But  
6 railroad companies shall not be required to trans-  
7 port more than one bicycle for a single person.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
