## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for  
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-  
6 ber, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine,  
7 to wit:—

8 For the salary of the state fire marshal, forty-  
9 five hundred dollars. [Acts 1894, chap. 444.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$4,500.)

10 For the salary of the deputy fire marshal,  
11 twenty-five hundred dollars. [Acts 1894, chap.  
12 444.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$2,500.)

13 For the salary of the clerk of the state fire

14 marshal, fourteen hundred dollars. [Acts 1895,  
15 chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$1,400.)

16 For the salaries of the two stenographers in the  
17 office of the state fire marshal, eleven hundred  
18 dollars each. [Acts 1895, chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$2,200.)

19 For the salaries of the two chiefs of aids in the  
20 office of the state fire marshal, twelve hundred  
21 dollars each. [Acts 1895, chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$2,400.)

22 For the salaries of nine aids in the office of the  
23 state fire marshal, one thousand dollars each; and  
24 for the salary of a messenger, four hundred dol-  
25 lars. [Acts 1895, chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$9,400.)

26 For travelling, contingent and incidental ex-  
27 penses, the same to include the services and ex-  
28 penses of persons employed in outside secret  
29 investigations and fees of witnesses, under the  
30 direction of the state fire marshal, a sum not ex-  
31 ceeding ten thousand five hundred dollars. [Acts  
32 1894, chap. 444; 1895, chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$10,500.)

33 For postage, printing, stationery, telephone, tel-  
34 egrams, incidental and contingent office expenses  
35 of the state fire marshal, a sum not exceeding  
36 twenty-five hundred dollars. [Acts 1894, chap.  
37 444; 1895, chap. 452.]

(Appropriation 1898, \$2,500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
