In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Andover to unite under a Board of Public Works its Board of Water Commissioners and its Board of Sewer Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Andover may at its next
2 regular town meeting or at a special town meeting called
3 for that purpose elect a board of public works, to consist
4 of not less than three nor more than six members, who
5 shall serve for three years.

1 SECTION 2. The said board of public works shall
2 have all the rights, powers and authority vested in the
3 water commissioners of Andover under chapter four
4 hundred and thirty-nine, acts of eighteen hundred and
5 eighty-seven, and amendments thereto, and in the board
6 of sewer commissioners under chapter three hundred and
7 eighty-six, acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and
8 amendments thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
