AN ACT

To Authorize the Treasurer of the County of Bristol  
to Employ Additional Clerical Assistance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer of the county of  
2 Bristol may employ additional clerical assistance  
3 in his office at an annual expense not to exceed  
4 three hundred dollars.
