## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

### AN ACT

To exempt from Equitable Process the Sum of not less than  
Ten Dollars per Week of Debtor's Income.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter five hundred and  
2 forty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
3 ninety-eight is hereby amended by striking out the word  
4 "reasonable," in the fortieth line thereof; and by insert-  
5 ing in the forty-first line thereof, after the word "family,"  
6 the words, "not less than ten dollars per week," so as  
7 to read as follows:—

8 Section 1. The clerk of any police, district or municipi-  
9 pal court of the district in which the debtor resides shall,

3 having served upon either or both of said courts at least  
 4 fifteen consecutive years, shall have become incapacitated  
 5 from the full discharge of his duties as such justice by  
 6 reason of sickness or otherwise may, with the approval  
 7 of the governor and council, resign his office under the  
 8 provisions of this section, and shall thereupon during the  
 9 residue of his natural life receive the same salary, to be  
 10 paid in the same manner, as provided in the first section  
 11 of this act.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter one hundred and sixty-two of  
 2 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five  
 3 and chapter four hundred and twenty of the acts of the  
 4 year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven are hereby  
 5 repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
