In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To increase the Money at the Disposal of the Metropolitan
Park Commission for a Parkway or Boulevard to and
around Spy Pond.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission created
2 by chapter four hundred and seven of the acts of the year
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-three, may, for the purposes
4 of constructing roadways and boulevards under the
5 authority of chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the
6 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four and of
7 any acts in amendment thereof or in addition thereto,
8 and especially for the purpose of providing a boulevard
9 or parkway from Mystic river to and along or around

10 Spy pond as part of an extension of the Mystic valley
11 parkway to Charles river by Spy pond and Fresh pond,
12 expend the further sum of one hundred and fifty thousand
13 dollars in addition to all sums heretofore authorized to be
14 expended by it; and to meet expenditures incurred under
15 authority of this act the treasurer and receiver general
16 shall issue a corresponding amount of scrip or certificates
17 of indebtedness as an addition to the metropolitan parks
18 loan, series two, and shall add to the existing sinking
19 fund heretofore authorized to provide for the payment of
20 the same. Said scrip or certificates of indebtedness
21 shall be issued and additions to said sinking fund so
22 established shall be assessed and collected in accordance
23 with the provisions of said chapter two hundred and
24 eighty-eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
25 ninety-four, and the provisions of chapter two hundred
26 and eighty-three of the acts of the year eighteen hun-
27 dred and ninety-five and chapter five hundred and fifty
28 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
