In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Cambridge to vacate Certain Sewer Assessments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Cambridge, with the assent
2 thereto of the respective owner or owners thereof, bind-
3 ing themselves, their respective heirs and assigns, may
4 vacate assessments imposed upon real estate for certain
5 common sewers built pursuant to an agreement dated
6 April sixteenth, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 six, entered into by the said city with the Bay State
8 brick company under the provisions of chapter one hun-
9 dred and seventy-five of the acts of the year eighteen
10 hundred and ninety-six.

1 SECTION 2. All lands upon which said assessments
2 have been so vacated shall be again assessed for such

3 sewers whenever the owners or occupants of said lands
4 shall connect with said sewers.

1 SECTION 3. Assessments made under the preceding
2 section shall constitute a lien upon the real estate so
3 assessed, and shall be collected and enforced, with the
4 same rights to owners to surrender their estates and the
5 same proceedings thereupon, and with the same rights of
6 appeal and proceedings upon appeal as are provided by chapter
7 fifty-one of the Public Statutes.

1 SECTION 4. A description of the property upon
2 which said assessments have been vacated, sufficiently
3 accurate for identification thereof, with the written
4 assent of the owner or owners of said property indorsed
5 thereon, shall be filed by the latter within sixty days
6 after the date of the order vacating such assessment, in
7 the registry of deeds for the southern district of Mid-
8 dlesex county.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the city council of the city of Cambridge.
