In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To provide for the Removal of the Remains of the
Dead from the Old Burial Lots in Malden.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden may remove
2 the remains of the dead and the monuments
3 erected to their memory from the old burial lots
4 located on Medford street, in said city of Malden,
5 upon land of the Robinson Brothers, near their
6 factory, to the Bell Rock cemetery in said city.

1 SECTION 2. Said city shall fix a time for the
2 removal of said remains and monuments, and
3 shall publish notice thereof once each week for

4 three successive weeks in some newspaper pub-
5 lished in said city, the last publication thereof to
6 be at least seven days before the time fixed for
7 said removal.

1 SECTION 3. Upon a request in writing by any
2 relative or friend of a person whose remains are
3 to be removed, said remains shall be interred and
4 said monuments erected in any other cemetery,
5 said relatives or friends first paying the expenses
6 of the removal and interment.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
