### AN ACT

#### Relative to Auctioneers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter sixty-seven of the  
2 Public Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and  
3 eighty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
4 eighty-six, is hereby amended by striking out in the  
5 second line thereof the words, "by writing under their  
6 hands," so as to read as follows:—

7 *Section 1.* The mayor and aldermen or selectmen of  
8 any city or town may license one or more suitable per-  
9 sons, who have resided in their respective cities and towns  
10 for a period of six months before application is made for  
11 such license, to be auctioneers within the same for the  
12 term of one year, and may receive to the use of the city  
13 or town for each license two dollars. They shall record  
14 every license in a book to be kept by them for that pur-  
15 pose.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
