

HOUSE No. 802.

[Bill accompanying the petition of the Trustees of Donations to the Protestant Episcopal Church. Parishes and Religious Societies.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

AN ACT

To authorize the Trustees of Donations to the Protestant Episcopal Church to hold additional Real and Personal Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter ninety of the acts
2 of the year eighteen hundred and ten is hereby amended
3 by striking out in the last clause thereof the words
4 “shall not exceed at any one time in the annual income
5 thereof, actual or estimated, the sum of fifteen thousand
6 dollars,” and inserting in place thereof the words “shall
7 not exceed at any one time in the annual income thereof
8 collected by said corporation the sum of forty thousand
9 dollars,” so that the last clause in said section three shall
10 read as follows:—

11 " Provided that the estates, real and personal, which
12 may be vested in said corporation, other than such estates
13 and property as may be conveyed or assigned in trust for
14 the support of a religious pastor or teacher as aforesaid,
15 shall not exceed at any one time in the annual income
16 thereof collected by said corporation the sum of forty
17 thousand dollars."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
