AN ACT

To authorize the Employment of a Messenger in the
Department of the Auditor of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The auditor of the Commonwealth
2 may employ in his department a messenger, who
3 shall receive a salary not exceeding nine hundred
4 dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
